1. THE LONDON EDITION (10 Berners Street)

- 2. OXFAM (52 Goodge Street, London W1T 4LZ) A classic. There's a great one on Goodge Street. I once found a first edition of Isabella Rossillini's biography in hard back at an Oxfam, with wonderful family pictures. A real gem. Here you can get carpets, earrings, clothes and bric a brac. It's definitely worth checking out.
- 3. ALFIE'S ANTIQUE MARKET (13-25 Church St, London NW8 8DT) I love Alfie's antique market. One of my favourite places in London. Even if you're strapped for cash, it's a wonderful place to just a browse. It's got everything from the perfect 1960s lampshade, to the original 1950s varsity jacket, to a diamond ring. One of my favourite stalls is the old buttons one. Hundreds of buttons to look through. A great way to spend a rainy afternoon. Alfie's could only be in London!
- **4.** VINTAGE MODES (1-7 Davies Mews, London W1K 5AB) I love the women that run this fantastic shop. They have a wonderful eye for vintage. I've fallen in love with so many pieces over the years, from old Westwood T-shirts to Celine blouses to a 1950s Dior cape. It's prior great classy vintage.
- **5.** LIBERTY LONDON (Regent St, London W1B 5AH) Liberty is a must-visit for anyone shopping in London, but if you want to splash out they also sell vintage bags and clothing from classic Chanel handbags to Louis Vuitton luggage and vintage wedding dresses, each piece is professionally cleaned and restored before it hits the shop floor.
- **6.** BEYOND RETRO (O58-59 Great Marlborough Street, London W1F 7JY) You want an old classic denim jacket or a beat up boiler suit? Look no further. Much of their stuff comes from Canada and the US. And you can tell. In a good way. It's real hard wearing great authentic stuff, which lots of cool and original pieces in the mix.
- 7. REIGN (12 Berwick St, London W1F 0PN) Reign is a real gem and found on Berwick Street market. The clothes are always organised, laundered and there are some real bargains to be found. One of my favourite recent finds was a frilly pie-crust collar blouse that would do Princess Diana proud.
- **8.** IDEAS BOOKS AT DOVER STREET MARKET (18-22 Haymarket, London SW1Y 4DG) Ideas Books recently published my book with Kira Jolliffe, Fanpages, and I can't complain as Vogue.com called them "The coolest publisher in the world". Ideas Books also source the most incredible rare second-hand art, fashion and design books. You can find them on the lower-ground floor of DSM.
